



Furry Guests

The basics

- We try to check the gates in the backyard to ensure they're closed prior to your arrival - but please double-check behind us before letting your dog run free.
- Raleigh has strict leash and pet-waste laws. Leashes, bags, and drying towels are in the cabinets on the screened-in porch. Waste bags go in the brown trash bin at the carport.
- Do not leave your pet unattended in the backyard (our neighbor has an infant!).
- Take advantage of the fenced dog-trot for bathroom breaks (see *Dog trot below*).
- Please clean up any household messes with supplies under the kitchen sink.
- All other supplies are in the hutch on the screened-in porch. There you'll find stainless steel food and water bowls, placemats, leashes, shampoo, drying towels, etc. Please include the bowls with your other dishes in the dishwasher at check-out.

Dog trot

- There is a dedicated dog trot in the backyard, perfect for quick trips to the bathroom. Go out any of the back doors, and the trot runs along the right-hand side of the yard.
- Close the two swinging gates on the deck to restrict access to the deck and dog trot.
